This Privacy Policy for House of Mercy describes:

- The personal information we collect and how we use it

This Privacy Policy applies to residents of the United States only. Our website and services are not intended for individuals located outside the United States.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND HOW WE USE IT

Contact Information:

We collect your name, address, phone number, email address, employer/company/organization name, job title, and similar contact details. We use this information to provide updates, content, and information that may be interesting or useful to you.

Payment History:

We use this information for accounting, invoicing, event registration, donation tracking, and to thank you for your contributions. We do not store your credit card information. All credit card payments are securely routed through payment card industry-compliant third-party services.

Technical Information:

We may also collect data such as your browser type (e.g., Google Chrome, Safari), operating system (e.g., Windows, macOS), device specifications (e.g., Intel Core CPU), internet connection type, IP address, geographic location, and the domain of your internet service provider. This information helps us improve website functionality and understand user behavior.

COOKIES AND SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES USED ON THIS WEBSITE

We use cookies to collect non-identifying information about user behavior and preferences. Types of cookies we may use include:

- Session-based cookies, which expire after you close your browser
- Persistent cookies, which remain on your device until manually deleted

These are used to support website analytics and user experience.

Our website may also use services such as Google Analytics, which collect information consistent with Google's Privacy Policy. This includes device-specific data, location, log data, and cookie usage. House of Mercy uses this information to understand website traffic and improve marketing efforts.

WE DO NOT KNOWINGLY COLLECT INFORMATION FROM CHILDREN

Our website is intended for a general audience of adults. We do not knowingly collect personal information from anyone under the age of 13 without verifiable parental consent, as defined under the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA). If we discover that we have collected such information without consent, we will delete it and only re-collect if appropriate consent is obtained.

PERSONAL INFORMATION WE SHARE

We do not sell your personal information.

We only disclose your information as described in this Privacy Policy or at the time data is collected. This may include:

- Payment Processing: Your payment details may be shared with trusted third-party processors solely to process your donations or transactions. These providers are required to safeguard your data and use it only for the services they perform on our behalf.
- Contractors and Vendors: House of Mercy may work with contractors and service providers to support our operations. They are contractually obligated to protect your data and use it only as instructed.
- Medical Emergency: If you attend a House of Mercy event, and we reasonably believe there is a medical emergency, we may share relevant personal information with medical professionals to protect your vital interests.
- Legal or Safety Necessity: We may disclose personal information if necessary to comply with legal obligations, protect your rights or those of others, or safeguard public safety.

YOUR RIGHTS AND CHOICES

You have rights regarding your personal information. These include the ability to:

- Limit the sharing of your data with third parties for marketing purposes
- Request confirmation that we maintain personal information about you
- Request access to, or a copy of, your personal information
- Correct or update inaccuracies in your personal information
- Object to or restrict how we process your data
- Request that we block or delete your data, as appropriate

To exercise these rights or update your preferences, contact us using the information below. You may withdraw consent for any use of your data, and we will apply your changes moving forward.

INFORMATION SECURITY

We take reasonable steps to protect your personal information and secure it against unauthorized access. All monetary transactions conducted on our site are encrypted using secure socket layer (SSL) technology.

While we implement safeguards to protect your data, no method of transmission over the internet or method of electronic storage is completely secure.
